The inexorable loss of biodiversity, climate change, global warming, the energy crisis, and not least the Covid-19 pandemic, are placing us in front of the need to act urgently, concretely, and across the board, to counter the effects of these pressures that are constantly increasing.

Forests, which alone cover almost half of the EU's land surface, are at the center of renewed attention for the fundamental role they play in protecting biodiversity, absorbing and storing CO<sub>2</sub>, providing many ecosystem services, contributing to the development of circular bioeconomy and provide employment for around 2.6 million people, particularly in rural areas. The strategies implemented at European level, such as the "new EU Forest Strategy" and the EU Biodiversity Strategy for 2030, must be coherent with each other and contribute to the achievement of common objectives.

The project LIFE GoProFor, through the organization of this conference, wants to give its contribution on the issues of European strategies by sharing and promoting at European level the experience gained, the tools tested, the results obtained and the most successful strategies in the context of forest management in tune with the conservation of biodiversity within the Natura 2000 network.
